**Meeting on Zoom Platform, 10:00 Florence time** to discuss the following two points.

The agenda is the following:

- 1) Clarifying the scientific details of the Training Session in Elbasan,
- 2) Organizational aspects and costs (travel, hotel and so on).

1) About the next training week in Elbasan from January 28<sup>th</sup> to February 1<sup>st</sup>, preliminarily Giorgia Bulli hopes for the participation of Associated Partners. Moreover, she suggests to actively involve the Social Workers in order to respect the virtuous chain of impulses and feedback provided in the Project Work Package. Nonetheless, she invites to foresee the involvement of students in social work in particular on the day dedicated to Practical Exercises (Thursday, January 31<sup>th</sup>).

Laura Bini, in addition to what has been said, also emphasizes the importance of activities in small interdisciplinary working groups of mixed composition between academics and professionals, and of subsequent restitution of reflections and expanded discussion on preliminary results.

The participants, after an extensive debate, agree on the following points:

**- Monday, January 28<sup>th</sup> Main Theme: Assessment**

For the first day, after the opening of works with a Round Table, it was decided to dedicate the remaining training hours to Assessment Report presentation and Support techniques identification, organizing small working groups on specific topics.

**- Tuesday, January 29<sup>th</sup> Main Theme: Supervision in Social Work**

Experiences of pedagogical supervision in the Training Programs, comparing the experiences of each European and Albanian partner.

**- Wednesday, January 30<sup>th</sup> Main Theme: Supervision architecture model**

It was decided to dedicate a particular space of study to Ethical-deontological issues

**- Thursday, January 31<sup>th</sup> Main Theme: Practical Exercises**

Each work group will draw up a document proposing the new desired supervision model. On this day in particular, the contribution of students will also be requested and valued, as well as social workers already active "in field".

**- Friday, February 1<sup>st</sup> Main Theme: Implementation activities for an improved supervision**

Starting from what was analyzed and built together in the previous days, the works will conclude with the definition of the activities of the year 2019 both in terms of innovations in the student's agenda and of new instruments for the supervision to be implemented.

2) Shared in detail the availability and needs of the participants in the mission for each group of Project Partners, it is agreed to proceed as much as possible in line with the project travel plan.
