At 12:00 the meeting is opened.

The discussion develops following the agenda.

1) Lisbon meeting agenda and expectations

Giorgia Bulli recalls the main aims of the next P1 P2 P3 P7 meeting in Lisbon at the beginning of October. First of all, the importance of reaching the goal of a preliminary elaboration of the structure of the internship procedures guidelines is underlined. A structure that will be finalized into the final version of the *GUIDELINES FOR THE INTERNSHIP* during the Internship training session in Shkoder (4-6 March 2020: P3 P4 P5 P6 P7).

Ahead of the Lisbon Meeting, Giorgia Bulli points out that it is very important to fill in the questionnaire-interview (forwarded via e-mail a few days before to all partners) on the history, structure, strengths and weaknesses of curricular internships at the Bachelor Level and at the Master level is particularly important. Moreover, Jorge Ferreira suggests to involve the Albanian partners - through virtual participation via skype and / or zoom platform - in the morning activities dedicated to analysis and discussion about the internship.

Giorgia Bulli remembers the appointment for 4-8 November in Tirana: it must be the moment of confrontation and conclusion on the drafting of new internship guidelines.

Laura Bini clarifies some changes and additions included in the survey form on the state of the art of curricular internships, a document now circulating among the partners to be compiled.

Jorge Ferrreira proposes to insert at the end of the first day of work a more theoretical intervention but of no less importance and interest. It was decided to accept the proposal and the Doctoral Conference Existentialism as a Basis for Social Work Theory by Dr Neil Thompson is included in the workshop program with Videotaped webinar, open to all partners.

The need to promote cross country mobility actions is reiterated - in particular by P3 and P7 - also from the perspective of the sustainability of the T @ sk Project itself

2) News about the EACEA reply (if available)

No significant news. The partners all still await feedback from EACEA auditors.

3) Distribution of the second tranche of the project's financing

Giorgia Bulli reiterates the need in short times to make requests to allocate the money provided for the purchase of equipment

4) Conference of Social Work in Elbasan in November 2019 (presentation of abstracts)

Elisabeta Osmanaj recalls the Third International Conference on Social Work, "Achievements and Challenges of the Occupation of Social Work in Albania", to be held on 8th November 2019 in Elbasan and invites partners to participate by sending in contributions

5) Book of Social Services and book presentation

With regard to the publication of the book on Social Services in Albania, partners P4, P5, P6 are invited to quickly contribute to the revision of the drafts.

6) Other - Extra Agenda

Giorgia Bulli invites all partners to join on October 3rd or 4th the webinar promoted by CBHE Team in EACEA (Unit A4) dealing with the preparation of the Project Final Report
